General Information for visitors to Koonwarra.

Welcome to Koonwarra, the small town with a big heart. We look forward to sharing this magical place with you.

GUIDE TO KOONWARRA FROM MELBOURNE:

Taking Monash Freeway (M1) and stay on M1 – Princes Fwy head towards Warragul, past Berwick.

Take the exit to Kooweerup/Pakenham (C422) turning right and head towards

Koo wee rup.

Follow to end and at the town of Koo wee rup, turn right then over the railway line and opposite Reserve turn left (sign says to Phillip Island).

Follow to end then turn left at the South Gippsland Highway. (M420)

Past roundabout take left entry to Leongatha/Foster /Wilson Prom (A440) South Gippsland Highway.

Drive past signs to Loch, through both Korrumburra, and Leongatha, then approximately 10 minutes and past livestock cattle yards heading towards Foster you will find lush Koonwarra.

(As this is a guide please consult your directory if in doubt – approx. one and half hours from Melbourne, one hour from Cranbourne, 30 mins from Inverloch and Foster)
